Thank you for your October 17, 2016 email in which you allege that Jim Cooper has violated certain provisions of chapter 42.17 A RCW. The purpose of this letter is to inform you the Thurston County Prosecuting Attorney Office will not be investigating your allegations or filing an action under the authority of RCW 42.17A.765.

Our office routinely defers to the Public Disclosure Commission and the Attorney General's Office on allegations regarding election law violations. These agencies have primary enforcement authority in this area and have the staffing and expertise to respond.
