
3 **STIPULATION**

4 The parties to this stipulation, Plaintiff, STATE OF WASHINGTON ex rel. GLEN  
5 MORGAN, and the Defendant, WALLA WALLA FIREPAC, a political committee, being  
6 desirous of resolving all claims arising out of the Plaintiff's complaint, hereby enter into the  
7 following stipulation:

- 8 1. Defendant agrees to pay to the State of Washington an assessed civil penalty in the  
9 amount of \$6,000 for violations of RCW 42.17A.
- 10 2. The parties agree that \$5,000 of the assessed civil penalty will be suspended based on the  
11 following terms and conditions:
- 12 a. The suspension will be in effect for four years from the date of execution of the  
13 Judgment. During the suspension, Defendant agrees that it will not violate any  
14 provision of RCW 42.17A.
- 15 b. In the event one or both of the Defendant is found by the Public Disclosure  
16 Commission or a court to have committed more than a de minimis violation of RCW  
17 42.17A during the suspension period, the suspended penalty of \$5,000 will  
18 immediately become payable within 30 days of such finding without further  
19 intervention of the Court.
- 20 c. If Defendant is not found to have committed violations of RCW 42.17 by the Public  
21 Disclosure Commission or a court for conduct during the suspension period, then the  
22 suspended portion of the penalty shall be set aside.

- 1 3. Defendant agrees to pay the State the unsuspended portion of the civil penalty (\$1,000)  
2 within 30 days of the date of entry of the Judgment.  
3 4. Defendant agrees to pay, in a separate transmittal, the total amount of \$5237.50 as  
4 attorney fees, court costs, and costs of investigation to Kover Law, PLLC on behalf of the  
5 Plaintiff, this amount to be paid within 30 days of the date of entry of the Judgment.

14 **JUDGMENT**

15 THIS MATTER came on regularly before the undersigned judge of the above-  
16 entitled Court. The Plaintiff, STATE OF WASHINGTON ex rel. GLEN MORGAN,  
17 appearing through its attorney of record, JUSTIN KOVER, and Defendant, WALLA  
18 WALLA FIREPAC, appearing through their attorneys, DANIELLE FRANCO-  
19 MALONE and DMITRI IGLITZIN, apprised the Court of their agreement to the entry of  
20 this judgment for the purpose of settling and compromising this action brought under  
21 RCW 42.17A. The Court, having reviewed the records and files herein, and having  
22 found the settlement to be a just and proper resolution of this matter, and being otherwise  
23 fully advised in the premises, now, therefore, hereby  
24

1           ORDERS that Defendant, WALLA WALLA FIREPAC, is hereby assessed a civil  
2 penalty, under the provisions of RCW 42.17A, in the amount of \$6,000 payable to the  
3 State of Washington. The Court further

4           ORDERS that the amount of \$5,000 of the assessed penalty is hereby suspended  
5 upon Defendant WALLA WALLA FIREPAC's compliance with the following court-  
6 ordered conditions:

- 7           a. The suspension will be in effect for four years from the date of execution of the  
8 Judgment. During the suspension, Defendant agrees that it will not violate any  
9 provision of RCW 42.17A.
- 10          b. In the event Defendant is found by the Public Disclosure Commission or a court  
11 to have committed more than a de minimis violation of RCW 42.17A during the  
12 suspension period, the suspended penalty of \$5,000 will immediately become  
13 payable within 30 days of such finding without further intervention of the Court.
- 14          c. If Defendant is not found to have committed violations of RCW 42.17A by the  
15 Public Disclosure Commission or a court for conduct during the suspension  
16 period, then the suspended portion of the penalty shall be set aside.

17 It is further

18           ORDERED that Defendant WALLA WALLA FIREPAC shall pay to the State of  
19 Washington the unsuspended portion of the assessed civil penalty (\$1,000) within 30 days of the  
20 entry of this Judgment. It is further

21           ORDERED that Defendant WALLA WALLA FIREPAC shall pay, in a separate  
22 transmittal, the total amount of \$5237.50 as attorney fees and court costs to Kover Law, PLLC
