Glen Morgan reported via the portal Sat, 21 Sept 2019 at 2:16PM

To whom it may concern,

It has come to my attention that Cydney Moore, running for Burien City Council, has committed numerous violations of Washington State's campaign finance laws (**RCW 42.17A**).

**1) Failure to accurately describe expense. (Violation of RCW 42.17A.240(6) & WAC 390-16037, RCW 42.17A.235)**

Moore's campaign has regularly failed to follow Washington State's Campaign Finance laws as they apply to the reporting of expenditures. Some C4s this campaign has filed contains violations of the statute and the rules written by the Public Disclosure Commission which support the statute.

Here are some examples that need to be corrected by Moore's campaign to at least go through the motions of complying with the statute: Examples of a failure to provide sufficient detail of expenditures (unambiguous violations of **RCW 42.17A.240(6)** and **WAC 390-16-037** (see **example B** provided at **WAC 390-16-037(3)**):

For example, the expenditures reported on **PDC Report #100918018** failed to report how many signs were printed and purchased from Abracadabra Printing. This is a clear violations of **WAC 390-16-037(3) example B** provided. There is no excuse for a failure to be fully transparent or compliant with the statute.

**2) Failure to provide accurate personal financial disclosure information in a timely manner (Violation of RCW 42.17A.700, .710)**

Moore's campaign appears to have **willfully concealed sources of income from the public and information regarding corporations and organizations from whom she apparently receives income**. Please see the attached F1 filed by this campaign. PDC staff should note that only one source of income is publicly disclosed, and this is the child support provided by Des Moines City Council candidate Anthony Martinelli of somewhere between \$1 – \$4,499 annual income.

On Moore's own campaign website, she indicates that she has "...spent several years as the owner of a successful small business." (see attached screen capture, as well as the original website link here: <http://electcydney.com/>). However, no income from that business or any affiliation with any additional business is provided in her financial affairs documents.

Additionally, also according to her campaign website she states "I currently serve on the Board of Trustees and as Secretary of the Burien Arts Association, as a Lead Organizer for ACLU Burien People Power, and as Co-coordinator of the Burien ICE rapid response team." (see attached screen capture, as well as the original website link above). However, nothing about these organizations is provided or documented in Moore's financial affairs documents. Either she is lying on her campaign website, or she has concealed these affiliations from the public in her Campaign Finance filings.

Additionally, Moore is identified as a "Founder" of the Joint Blog (see attached screen capture) which, according to the other founder, Anthony Martinelli, receives millions of views and obviously has paid advertising on its website. None of this information is provided in Moore's F1 statement either.

Finally, on a reported annual income of \$4,499, which is the only income information provided in this politician's financial affairs statements, it would be financially impossible to live at the address listed by this candidate as her primary address. Please see the attached screen capture of a fairly recent rental listing for a 1 bedroom apartment at this location for \$1200 per month. Even using common core math, this would mean a minimum expense of \$14,400 annually, which, when combined with food, transportation, presumably child care (for which these funds are intended) and other basic living expenses means that this politician has willfully concealed sources of income from the public in her financial affairs statement. This means the F1 filed by this candidate is inaccurate, fraudulent and false, and the willful and knowing filing of fraudulent information like this to the PDC is likely a violation of **RCW 42.17A.750 (2)(a) or (b)**.

The PDC should conduct a thorough review of this campaign to identify other violations which may have been committed.

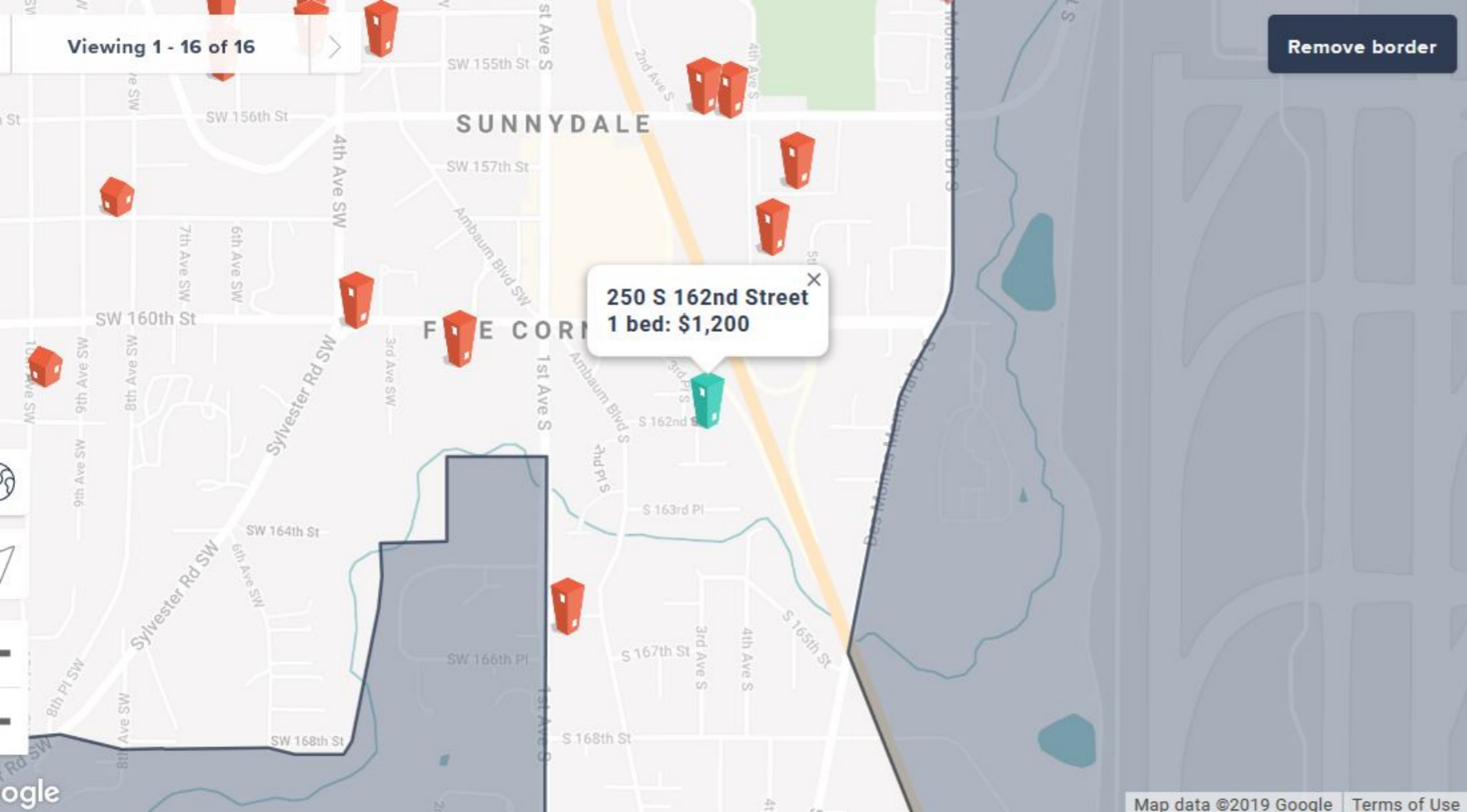

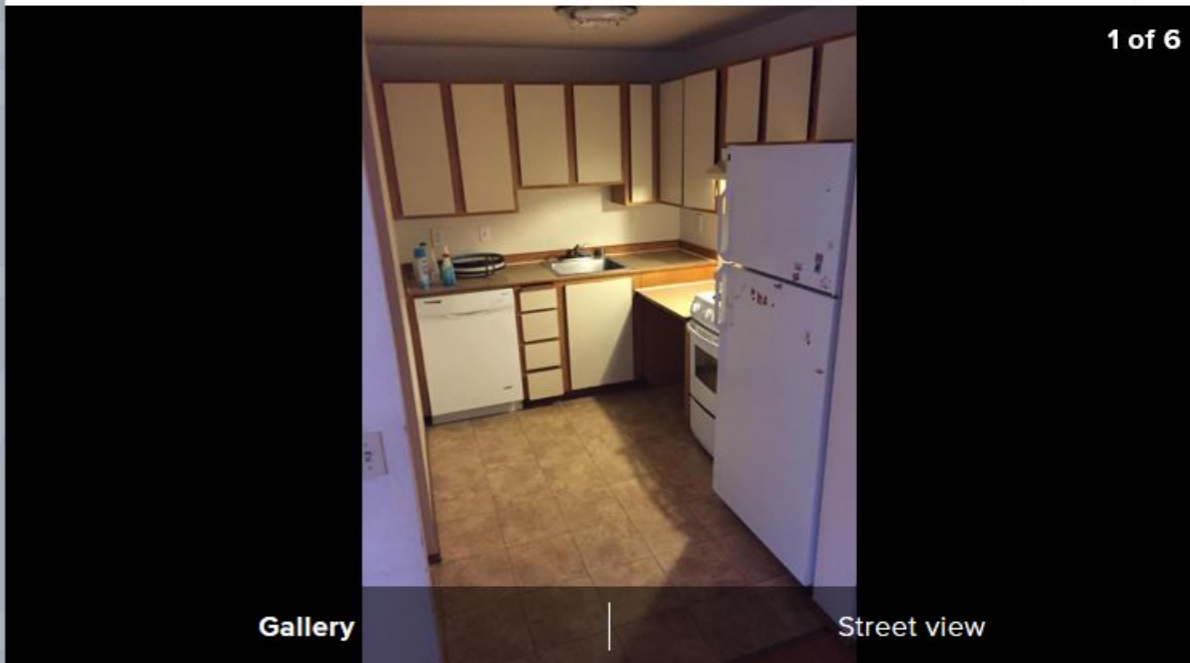
