## THE RECALL OF JASON WHITE, CITY OF YAKIMA DISTRICT 2 COUNCILMAN.

DECLARATION OF DAVID BRIGGS

- I, DAVID BRIGGS, declare under penalty of perjury in the State of Washington that the following statements are true, based on my personal knowledge.
  - I am over the age of 18, I am competent to provide testimony in this matter, and I do so based on my personal knowledge.
  - 2. I am a resident of Yakima, WA, and I reside in the city voting district designated as District 2. Respondent White is the official currently representing my district.
  - 3. I am a member of local civic groups, along with attorney Liz Hallock.
  - 4. I am a regular reader of the Yakima Herald newspaper for 16 years.
  - I have personal knowledge of the alleged facts upon which the stated grounds for recall are based.
  - As detailed in the Petition for Recall, Mr. White's statements on Facebook were reprinted in the Yakima Herald.
  - 7. As detailed in the Petition for Recall, Mr. White's conduct in detracting from the City's

efforts to voluntarily impose disease control measures was recounted in the *Yakima Herald* and the *Seattle Times*. I have read all of these articles; these papers have no paywall for COVID-19 coverage.

- 8. I also have seen Mr. White's Facebook posts.
- I am actively involved in the community. I am aware of Mr. White's conduct and his attempt to interfere with the local and state stay-at-home orders.
- 10. On or about April 13th, I joined this effort to recall Mr. White, along with Ms. Hallock.
- 11. Ms. Hallock had some concerns about members in the community being harassed on social media by Mr. White.
- 12. After consulting with the auditor's office, we resubmitted the Petition for Recall, along with my affidavit of personal knowledge on April 17<sup>th</sup>.
- 13. Ms. Hallock's concerns about Mr. White proved correct when Mr. White posted a copy of the recall petition on social media, disparaged Ms. Hallock, and disparaged a voter's genitalia.
- 14. Ms. Hallock submitted a Notice of Appearance on May 6<sup>th</sup> and is currently representing me in this matter.
