17 1. I am Jason White and am competent to testify, over the age of eighteen, and make
18 this statement upon my personal knowledge.

19 2.
20 On April 16th 2020 I, Jason White, was served a "petition to recall Yakima city councilman Jason White" from
21 Kathy Fisher and Charles Ross, this petition was labelled to be from Elizabeth Hallock and no other
22 petitioners. This petition was only signed and dated by Elizabeth Hallock on April 14th 2020.
23 On Wednesday May 13th, having not been served or having received any other information on this petition, I
24 went to the Yakima County Courthouse to see if there was a hearing date due to a social media post from Liz
25 Hallock stating that there was a hearing on May 13th. At that time I got a hearing schedule from the Yakima
26 County Clerk's office. That day I attended the hearing via Zoom. At this time the judge set a new date for the
27 hearing in 2 weeks, for May 27th.
28 On May 15th 2020 I met up with the Yakima County prosecutor Joe Brusie to receive the revised petition. At
that time I received a petition that was filed on April 16th, 2020 by Liz Hallock and on April 17th David Briggs
signed and filed with the Auditor an affidavit affirming that he believes the statement of charges filed by Ms.
Hallock to be true.

After the May 13th Zoom meeting Ms. Hallock came onto my personal Facebook post accusing me of lying to
the judge about receiving the petitions and "perjuring" myself.


Ms. Hallock has a long history of running for political office unsuccessfully. In the 3 years I have been a part
of the Yakima City Council Liz Hallock has ran for 3 positions, State Rep, City Council and currently
Washington State Governor.

Listed on the Governors recent stay home violation list. Liz Hallock reports my business Yakima Reclaimed

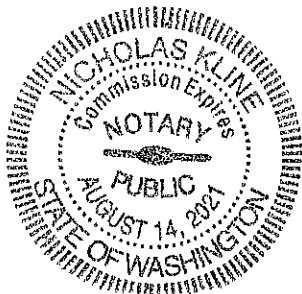
1 and states "Jason White, an elected city of Yakima official, under an oath of office, is not following the
2 Governor's stay home stay healthy order. He is not only operating a non-essential business, he is violating
3 social distancing orders and encouraging others to do as well on his Facebook page. He is calling the Yakima
4 Herald, Jay Inslee, and the city council idiots, fools, etc and downplaying the dangers of Covid."
5 These actions are consistent with a grudge against me for my personal behavior, and a long running vendetta,
6 rather than complaints against my actions in my official capacity.
