DECLARATION OF ELIZABETH HALLOCK

I, ELIZABETH HALLOCK, declare under penalty of perjury in the State of Washington that the following statements are true, based on my personal knowledge.

- I am over the age of 18, I am competent to provide testimony in this matter, and I do so based on my personal knowledge.
- 2. I am a resident of the political subdivision of Yakima, WA and registered voter here.
- I submitted a Petition to Recall the above-named Councilman White on April 14th. It is not required to be "served" on the Auditor, but "filed" in the same manner as commencing a civil case in Superior Court. RCW 29A.56.120.
- 4. I asked the Auditor if a voter in the City of Yakima election district 2 would be required to join the Petition.
- 5. Around April 16th, according to the County Auditor, it was required that in order to accept the Petition, a voter in the District 2 election district must join the Petition. Mr.

Briggs had already agreed to join the Petition a few days earlier.

- 6. After consulting with the auditor's office, we resubmitted the entire Petition for Recall, along with Mr. Briggs' affidavit of personal knowledge on April 17th.
- I have attached the correspondence with the Auditor regarding adding an additional Petitioner to this Declaration as Attachment 1.
- 8. I received a brief from the Yakima County Prosecuting Attorney that indicated that because I was not a resident of the election district 2, I could not be a Petitioner in this matter. No case law was cited.
- 9. On April 19th, I submitted to the auditor two supplemental exhibits to the Petition for Recall. I also emailed these to the County Attorneys' office. One exhibit was a code section on health authority emergency orders. The second exhibit contained a Facebook post of Mr. White's encouraging insurrection. It shows Respondent had knowledge and intent to violate the stay-at-home orders and had knowledge and intent in his encouragement of others to violate the law.
- 10. For reasons that are no fault of the Petitioner, Mr. White was not served with these two exhibits along with the Petition for Recall.
- 11. I submitted a Notice of Appearance on May 6th and currently represent David Briggs as the Petitioner in this matter. While I was an original petitioner, I have voluntarily ceded that role to Mr. Briggs.
