Dear **San Juan PAC** c/o Northwest Passage Consulting, LLC / Christian Sinderman:

Enclosed is a copy of an electronic letter sent to Glen Morgan concerning a complaint filed with the Public Disclosure Commission (PDC).

As noted in the letter to Glen Morgan, the PDC has dismissed this matter in accordance with RCW 42.17A.755(1) and will not be conducting a more formal investigation into these allegations or taking further enforcement action in this matter.

However, pursuant to WAC 390-37-060(1)(d), this letter serves as a warning letter concerning the failure of San Juan PAC to properly report activities totaling \$7,000 supporting six charter amendments on the November 2, 2021 general election ballot in San Juan County. San Juan PAC was required to file a C-6 to report political advertising costing \$1,000 or more, appearing within 21 days of an election. In addition, San Juan PAC was required to timely register and report as a political committee and was required to be listed as the sponsor on the advertising. Staff expects you to file all future required reports of contributions and expenditures properly and timely and to properly identify the sponsor on political advertising. The Commission will consider the formal written warning in deciding on further Commission action if there are future violations of PDC laws or rules.
