Dear PDC,

Below are my responses to a Glen Morgan complaint dated Mon, 21 Oct 2019

1. Mr. Wyble billed the campaign for professional services and paid communication during the campaigns below.

I am a divorced single woman and my ex husband signed over the property of the houses to me so that I could refinance the houses due to 2 heloc loans. These loans were an arm through Bank of America. I could not qualify to refinance the houses with my 2 year term as an elected official and with my own personal income. John Wyble is my significant other and with his personal income we were able to refinance the homes and stabilize the loans through a 30year fixed mortgage. We have lived together since 2014 and this was not a business transaction.

Mr. John Wyble the principle of Winpower Strategies has been my political consultant. I have a paid primary campaign manager for each campaign.

2014 Ms. Jean Blackburn was both my paid campaign manager and treasurer.

2016 Ms. Lori Rock was my paid campaign manager and Ms. Stephanie Schlegel was my paid treasurer.

2018 Mr. Travis Schlegel was my paid campaign manager and Ms. Stephanie Schlegel was my paid treasurer

2. A. PDC report #100756349 The "rally signs" were for a response to a local hate crime event in partnership with local religious institutions. We thought that all funds ever used must match the actual year that the funds were raised.

B. PDC report #100876294 "Fighting for the Majority" is an appropriate use of surplus funds because it is the House Democratic Campaign Caucus.

3. There were emails sent out to the donors to notify them of the transfer of funds.

4. PDC Report #100711626 There were 13,000 total pieces of literature. 2,000 were walk pieces and the rest was for the first mail piece. Payment for the printing was on 6/23/16 for 5,874.00 to Winpower Strategies. PDC Report #100714274 - There were 450 signs printed from vendor Capital City Press and the amount was paid to Winpower Strategies.

PDC Report #100728210 included the mailer pieces (11,180 pieces) and the 2,348.63 to Capital City Press was the cost of the postage and mailing services for this mail piece.

Thank you for the opportunity to respond to the alleged allegations.
