To whom it may concern,

It has come to my attention, that Kathleen Martin, during her recent failure as a political candidate for the Seattle City Council in 2019, unfortunately, appears to have violated Washington State’s campaign finance laws (**RCW 42.17A**) very impressively, the specific violations are detailed below:

**1) Attempting to conceal the truth about political activity from the public by waiting weeks, months, or more to report what they did or who funded them (Violation RCW 42.17A.235, RCW 42.17A.240)**

First, let’s just review the late reporting, which is essentially an effort by this failed political candidate to conceal the truth from the public for as long as she believes she can. Even a casual review of this politician’s campaigns reveals something seriously wrong here. It is particularly concerning since many of these reports were actually filed months late finally revealing the reported truth about this campaign that was concealed from the public during the campaign itself. Who knows if anything in these reports is accurate right now? This is another good example of a case where a quick and simple subpoena of bank records would help the PDC in its investigation.

As usual, I try to provide the specific examples of lawbreaking in a very easy-to-read and simpler to understand spreadsheet format. This is both for PDC staff convenience, but it also helps the lawbreakers use the list as a reference sheet so that they can go back and try to explain, justify, or excuse their repetitive lawbreaking activities. I’ve attached this both as an Excel file and a PDF so that everyone involved can get the optimal value from the effort. Please note that the original report referenced in the spreadsheet can be linked by clicking on the far-right column. I believe this makes it easier for everyone.

A quick note again on how this report is organized. I’ve **organized it by latest report first**. You’ll note that the latest report filed by this failed politician was 380 days late (well past a year – even for common core kids) which is a bit ridiculous. **There is always something wrong when a candidate is filing so many reports so late and therefore concealing the truth about their campaign from the public for so long.**

**I've color coded the most extreme late reports red, as usual, of which there are 164.** For a campaign that was nuked in the primary, this is a shocking number of egregiously late reports. I've color coded the problematically late orange, and there are only 21 of those 12-6 days late. Illegal, but not as egregious as most of this politician's reports. Even just these reports alone might justify notice to the PDC, but they are overwhelmed by the more egregious volume of super late reporting color coded red in the attached spreadsheets. **Frankly, it is hard to find a report by this short live aborted political campaign that was filed on time.** I've color coded the sloppily late reports yellow, and there are only 34 of those. If this campaign had just been typically sloppy with their reporting, I wouldn't have filed this complaint. So, it appears that when this politician wanted to break the law (which appears to be her choice most of the time), she just goes for months or even a year and conceals everything from the public. The attached spreadsheet and PDF file of this information should be adequate to verify this allegation. I'm sure every one of these violations has a story behind it – and it would be good to get a complete picture of the stories and yarns he will spin this time.

By the way, this extensive and exhaustive list of violations clearly indicates that it is highly likely the reports recently filed and not yet refiled are inaccurate, and it would not a bad idea for PDC staff to subpoena the bank records and see how far off the C3 and C4 reports have been when filed on behalf of this politician.

## **2) Failure to accurately describe expenses, and the illegal concealment of required information from the public (Violation of RCW 42.17A.240, RCW 42.17A.235 & WAC 390-16-037)**

Once I realized this politician would so egregiously violate the law with such reckless disregard for the public to know the truth, I kept looking closer. Not surprisingly considering the already documented fiasco above, it turns out this politician has failed to follow Washington State's Campaign Finance laws as they apply to the reporting of expenditures frequently (of course). Below **are a few specific examples of failing to follow the law. These are clear and explicit violations of WAC 390-16-037.**

For both staff and the lawbreaker's reference, **I will detail just a few of the many deficient examples provided**, so that the obvious lawbreaking can be more efficiently spotted and hopefully corrected in the future to prevent the need to file complaints like this one, and as I mentioned earlier, the violations of this kind seem to be a part of the culture of this campaign – will many problems on the same reports. Clearly this politician will need to go back and correct all these reports – years later, but better later than never:

- **(Violation Examples #1 - #5)** On **PDC Report #100951508, attached for staff reference**, this failed politician decided to hide the legally required details for claiming to spend \$1,622.29 for "Val-Pak slips" (how many? What timeframe?), and also claims to have spent \$600 for "insert into paper" (on two different expenditures) (how many? Which paper? What timeframe?, and also have spent \$1,482.89 for "newspaper" (how many? Which paper? When was it run (in which paper was it inserted?), another

\$1,694.57 for “ValPak” (again how many? When? What timeframe?) and also violations are explicit **violations of WAC 390-16-037, Example A.**

- **(Violation Example #6)** On **PDC Report #100954399, attached for staff reference**, this politician claims to have spent \$1,622.29 for “advertising” with ValPak (again, how many inserts? What timeframe?) Clear and **textbook violations of WAC 390-16-037, Example A.**
- **(Violation #7-#13)** On **PDC Report #100951566, attached for staff reference**, this politician committed **at least six different violations of WAC 390-16-037** – including no numbers on yard signs, no details on advertising, inserts, voter contact (digital ads?) etc. **Just every single time they were required to provide details, they decided to not comply.**
- **(Violation #14-#16)** On **PDC Report #100951500, attached for staff reference**, this politician **claims to have spent cash on yard signs, Facebook ads, “advertising”** Once again, no legally required details provided. This is information this politician must report to the public, and she chose to conceal it instead. Again, more **clear and obvious violations of WAC 390-16-037, Example B and A.**

I kept running into more problems with the expenditures of this campaign, which has forced me to branch into even more allegations related to what I have uncovered.

### **3) Illegal misuse of campaign resources for personal use (Violation of RCW 42.17A.445, WAC 390-16-238(4)(m))**

This politician seemed to abuse the trust the voters and donors placed in her campaign and misused these campaign expenses for personal benefit. For example, on **PDC C4 Report #100951504, attached for staff reference**, this politician claims she spent \$60.56 for a subscription to the Economist. This is actually an explicit violation of **WAC 390-16-238(4)(m)** which clearly states that she can’t use campaign funds to personal expenses like “magazine subscriptions.”

Of course, not content to commit this violation just once – this politician decided to do this twice. (See **PDC C4 Report #100951501, attached for staff reference**)

This politician must return these funds to the campaign or perhaps just forfeit them to the state since this bank account has probably been closed out. I have caught some politicians breaking this specific law before, but it has been a while. So once I realized this politician would misuse campaign funds for personal expenses so explicitly defined as illegal in the statute, I decided to look even closer.

### **4) Illegal misuse of campaign funds for personal use. Campaign can’t pay for Dick (Violation of RCW 42.17A.445, WAC 390-16-238(2))**

This politician misused campaign funds for personal meetings with Dick (See **PDC C4 Report #100934814, attached for staff reference**). As the law so clearly states, activities and meetings that are personal in nature and would happen anyway can’t use campaign funds. **The campaign**

**can't pay for Dick. Meeting Dick is a personal experience, not one that campaign funds need to pay for.**

In this specific Dick meeting expenditure – the actual Vendor identified is “The Alibi Room” which might have been appropriate for the experience, but that is not an alibi for an illegal expenditure for this Dick meeting. This politician can certainly meet with Dick on her own time and her own dime, but the campaign can't pay for Dick. Again, this politician will need to reimburse this defunct campaign (or forfeit to the state) the unrelated cost of meeting Dick.

As an aside, in case this politician claims that this Dick meeting is past the statute of limitations (because it supposedly happened on December 10, 2018), please note, the actual report (**PDC Report #100934814, attached for staff reference**) wasn't filed until late 2019, AFTER the campaign was long over, so this Dick meeting is still relevant for PDC investigation and should be reimbursed or forfeit funds.

Unfortunately, this campaign was riddled with a lot of questionable expenditures of a similar nature. Constant, unclear purchases of food or drinks for “Crew” which is almost as unclear as Dick.
